### 1. CEZD ASF Weekly Intelligence Report: January 17-24, 2019

Summary of Global Information
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• No new countries have reported being affected by ASF.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Disease continues to spread in Europe and China<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ <b>Europe</b> – the pattern of spread within Europe remains the same. Wild boar 'outbreaks' are usually only an individual animal or a small group.</li><li>○ <b>China</b> – The disease continued to spread in domestic swine and was reported in a new province, Ningxia.</li></ul></li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• ASF has <u>spread in Mongolia</u> and the OIE has now received five reports spread out over Mongolia.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Denmark <u>informed</u> the OIE that a simulation exercise on ASF will take place from January 28-31 2019. This full scale exercise on the control and eradication of ASF will aim to test and further develop the ASF contingency plan.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• ASF <u>detected</u> in pork products in Thailand at Phuket airport, nine ASF-contaminated pork products have been seized from tourists.</li></ul>

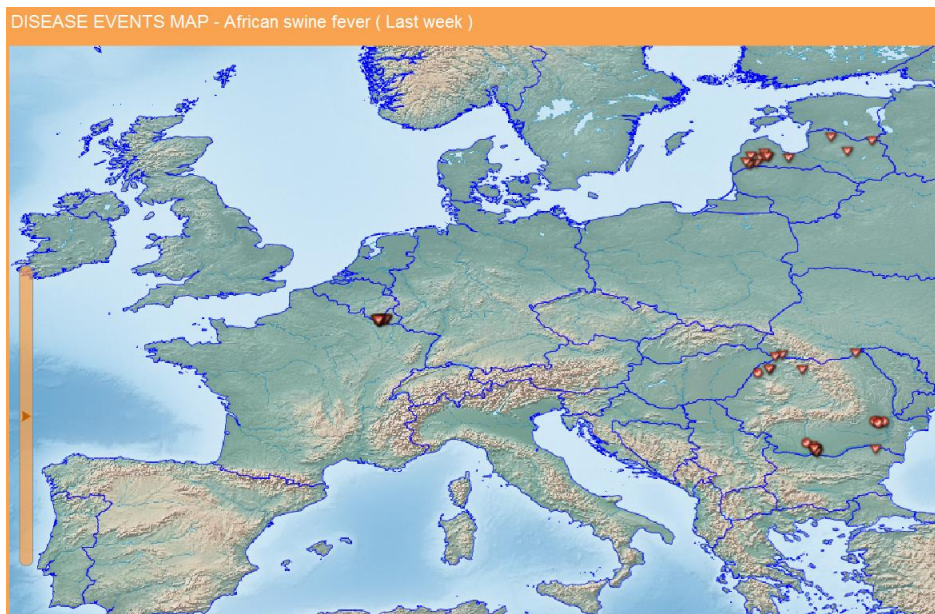
