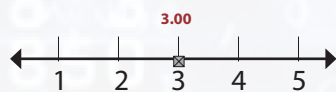

Description: African swine fever has spread to southern Cambodia's Kandal province, bringing the total number of provinces hit by the virus to five. The outbreak in Kandal was detected last week in the districts of Khsach Kandal and Sa'ang, where hundreds of pigs fell sick and died. The Agriculture Ministry issued a statement confirming that ASF has hit multiple communes in the province. It is suspected that the outbreak in Kandal may have come from neighbouring Takeo due to pig feed, which included pork products, being imported.

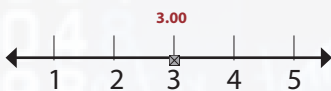

Description: African Swine Fever continues to spread in Europe. Bulgaria's Food Safety Agency has confirmed an outbreak of ASF among domestic pigs in the village of Zidarovo, in Sozopol municipality in the district of Bourgas. The outbreak was found at an unregistered private farm where 14 pigs were being reared. When agency officials visited the farm, only six live pigs were found. Euthanasia of all pigs in a three-kilometre safety zone in the area has begun, the agency said. A 10km monitoring zone also has been declared.

Description: With this new case, Laos now has 2 areas affected with ASF, Salavane province and Vientiane capital. Vientiane is on a bend of the Mekong River, at which point it forms the border with Thailand. The Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry confirmed the occurrence of the first ASF outbreak in Toumlan district, Salavane province on 20 Jun 2019. ASF is still spreading in the area, with number reported reaching 2616.
