

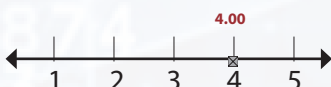
CEZD WEEKLY INTELLIGENCE REPORT

Disease: African Swine Fever (ASF)

Description: Eastern Europe is continuing to report outbreaks of African swine fever in domestic pigs. Slovakia has diagnosed its very first case of ASF found in a small backyard farm in the province of Kosice situated close to the Hungarian border. As for Bulgaria, it has confirmed an outbreak of ASF at a second industrial pig breeding farm where there are some 40,000 pigs.

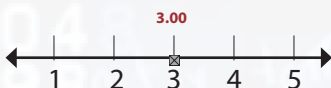

Description: Northern Lao province of Phongsaly has reported cases of the African swine fever. The outbreak occurred in Mone Sandhawan and Hat Saihua villages and approximately 338 pigs have died.

Description: Outbreaks of CSF continue to be reported in Japan. After a two week lull in reported outbreaks, Mie Prefecture and Gifu Prefecture are once again hit with outbreaks bringing the overall count to 33 farms. With the last outbreak in the Gifu Prefecture, Japan's Ministry of Agriculture (MAFF) has reported cases of CSF for the 6th time in the past 30 days.

Description: Last week, the Mississippi Board of Animal Health has confirmed seven cases of Eastern equine encephalitis (EEE) since June 7, 2019. New Jersey agricultural officials also reported a equine case of EEE in a 12-year-old mare in Ocean County. The horse had been previously vaccinated against EEE in April 2019 and was euthanized on July 23, 2019 making it the first case of EEE in New Jersey this year.
