**Description:** ASF continues to be reported in China. The province of Liaoning Sheng has confirmed additional cases in its domestic swine population.

**Description:** Eastern Europe is still reporting outbreaks of ASF in domestic pigs. Since July 31<sup>st</sup>, Bulgaria, Moldova and Slovakia have all reported new cases of the disease. As for Serbia, the competent services of the Veterinary Directorate carried out euthanasia of pigs in the villages of Rabrovac and Velika Krsna due to suspicion of a possible infectious disease and on the basis of the reported death of one pig. Confirmation of the disease is pending.

**Description:** Vietnam has reported the destruction of 12180 domestic pigs in the northern province of Dien Bien. Since the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development (MARD) confirmed its first ASF outbreak on 19 February 2019, a total of 62 provinces/cities reported outbreaks, about 3,700,000 pigs have been culled.

**Description:** According to Manitoba Pork, there has now been 60 cases of the porcine epidemic diarrhea (PED) virus confirmed in 2019 (24 finisher, 11 nursery, 24 sow, 1 quarantine). 48 of those are in southeast Manitoba, 9 west of the Red River in the Lowe Farm/Morris Area, 2 in Whitemouth, and 1 in Notre Dame de Lourdes.
