

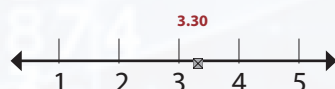
CEZD WEEKLY INTELLIGENCE REPORT

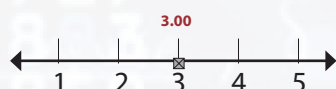

Description: African swine fever is now suspected to have infected Eastern Myanmar. Public attention rose after some 20 dead pigs were found floating in Loi Sone Stream, in Tachileik, on Monday, Aug. 5. The Administrative Department and the Livestock Breeding and Veterinary Department (LBVD) officials retrieved and buried the pigs. The Agriculture, Livestock and Irrigation Ministry has not confirmed whether the pigs are in fact plagued by African swine fever yet. Serum samples have been taken and tested in Yangon but the results have yet to return.

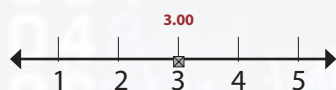

Description: Amid an escalation of African Swine Fever (ASF) cases in domestic pigs in eastern Europe, Bulgaria has culled about 130,000 pigs on large commercial farms in the country over recent weeks. According to recent reports by the World Organization for Animal Health (OIE), Bulgaria has reported more than 30 outbreaks across 10 regions since early July, including 6 on large commercial farms. Press agency Reuters reported that in a move to contain its spread, 20km sanitary zones have been set up around all registered industrial pig farms, with authorities ordering the culling of home-raised pigs by the Food Safety Agency in these zones.

Description: Japan has now confirmed it's 35th and 36th farm outbreak of Classical Swine Fever. The last two cases have been reported once again in the Aichi prefecture, in the domestic pig population. In total, 1014 pigs were culled. While Gifu Prefecture remains the epicenter of this (nearly year-long) outbreak, we've seen not only a geographic expansion, but an acceleration of outbreaks in the past few months.
