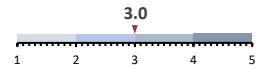

### African Swine Fever in Europe

- For the first time, a backyard farm in western [Poland](#), near the village of Ratowice (125km from the border of Germany), has tested positive for ASF
- [Slovakia](#), [Latvia](#), [Hungary](#), and [Romania](#) have reported cases of ASF in wild boar
- [Romania](#) has also reported outbreaks of ASF in domestic swine

- Worldwide, there were 9,072,657 cases of [COVID-19](#) with 471,177 deaths reported
- In [Canada](#), the National Microbiology Laboratory reported 101,337 cases of COVID-19 and 8,430 deaths: British Columbia (2790 confirmed, 168 deaths), Alberta (7704 confirmed, 152 deaths), Saskatchewan (746 confirmed, 13 deaths), Manitoba (313 confirmed, 7 deaths), Ontario (33,476 confirmed, 2606 deaths), Quebec (54,766 confirmed, 5417 deaths), Newfoundland and Labrador (261 confirmed, 3 death), New Brunswick (164 confirmed, 2 death), Nova Scotia (1061 confirmed, 62 deaths), Prince Edward Island (27), Yukon (11), Northwest Territories (5), Nunavut (0), repatriated Canadians (13)
- In [Denmark](#), 11000 mink are to be slaughtered at a farm in North Jutland after several of the animals and one employee tested positive for SARS-CoV-2
