- In [Canada](#), the National Microbiology Laboratory confirmed 110,338 cases of COVID-19 and 8,852 deaths: British Columbia (3198 confirmed, 189 deaths), Alberta (9219 confirmed, 167 deaths), Saskatchewan (943 confirmed, 15 deaths), Manitoba (343 confirmed, 7 deaths), Ontario (37,604 confirmed, 2751 deaths), Quebec (57,466 confirmed, 5655 deaths), Newfoundland and Labrador (262 confirmed, 3 death), New Brunswick (169 confirmed, 2 death), Nova Scotia (1067 confirmed, 63 deaths), Prince Edward Island (36), Yukon (13), Northwest Territories (5), Nunavut (0), repatriated Canadians (13)
- [Spain](#) has reported its first outbreak of SARS-CoV-2 on a mink farm located in the region of Aragon
- SARS-CoV-2 has been detected on another mink farm in the [Netherlands](#), bringing the total to 25
- A dog in Charleston County ([South Carolina](#)) was confirmed to test positive for SARS-CoV-2
