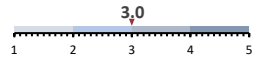

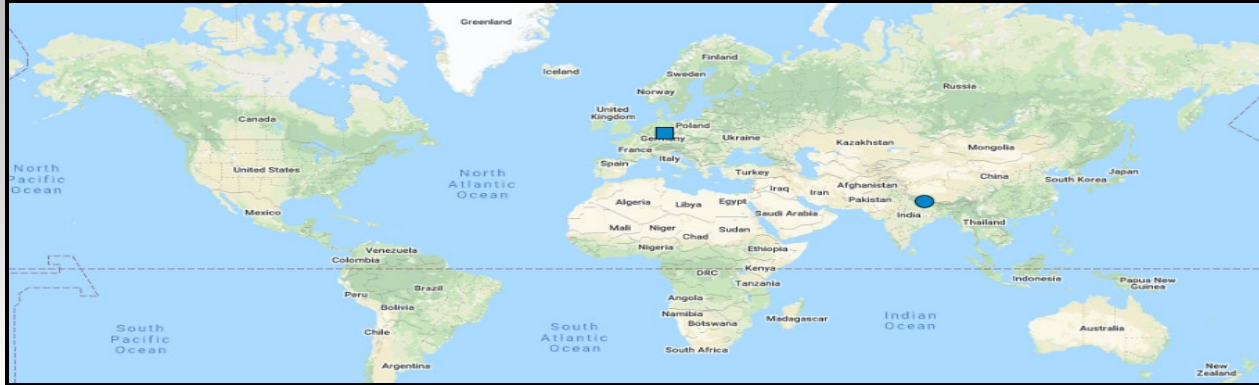

### ■ Suspected Lumpy Skin Disease in Nepal

**Pathogen:** Virus; **Transmission:** Vector borne; **Species affected in event:** Cattle

① Cattle displaying symptoms similar to lumpy skin disease have been found in Nepal. More than 1000 cows in Jhapa, Morang, Sunsari, Saptari, and other districts have contracted the disease, and 10-12 cows have died. Confirmation of the event in Nepal and its official notification are expected.

### ■ H1N1 Swine Flu in Germany

**Pathogen:** Virus; **Transmission:** Direct contact, fomite, aerosol; **Species affected in event:** Human

① Swine influenza A(H1N1)v was detected in a 2-year old male in Germany. Whole genome sequencing characterized this virus as a Eurasian avian-like swine A(H1N1) virus (1C.2.2) on 1 July. The patient had visited a swine farm and had close contact with pigs two days before onset of illness.
