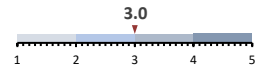

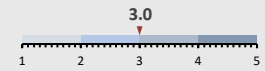

- Worldwide, there were 31,263,651 cases of COVID-19 with 965,398 deaths reported
- In Canada, the National Microbiology Laboratory reported 143,649 cases of COVID-19 and 9,217 deaths: British Columbia (7842 confirmed, 223 deaths), Alberta (16,381 confirmed, 255 deaths), Saskatchewan (1807 confirmed, 24 deaths), Manitoba (1586 confirmed, 16 deaths), Ontario (46,849 confirmed, 2827 deaths), Quebec (67,542 confirmed, 5802 deaths), Newfoundland and Labrador (272 confirmed, 3 death), New Brunswick (194 confirmed, 2 deaths), Nova Scotia (1086 confirmed, 65 deaths), Prince Edward Island (57), Yukon (15), Northwest Territories (5), Nunavut (0), repatriated Canadians (13)

- Florida has confirmed another case of equine EEE
- Probable cases of EEE case reported in LaPorte County, Indiana
- New Jersey has confirmed its first equine EEE Case
